

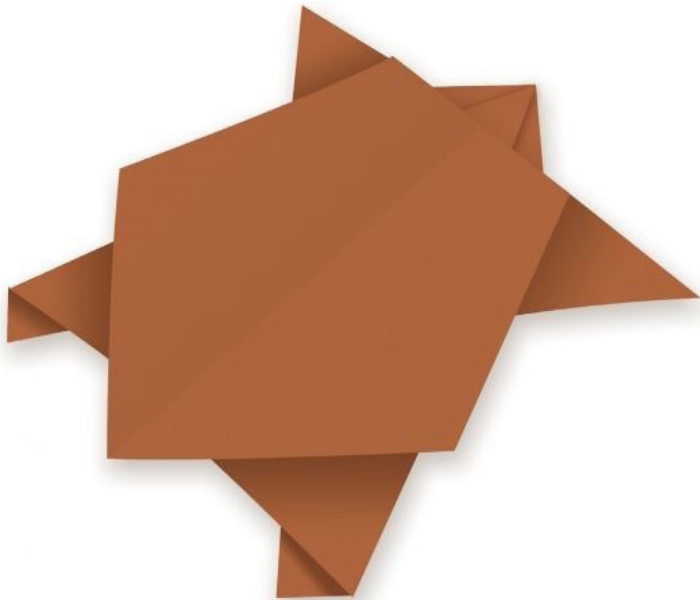
# Origami Sea Turtle















Make a paper reptile of your very own!



## MATERIALS:

8 1/2 X 11-INCH SHEET OF  
COLORED PAPER  
SCISSORS



1.  Fold one corner of a piece of paper over to the opposite corner.
2.  Finish making the square by cutting off the small rectangle.
3.  Fold side to side and unfold. This is the "valley fold" or "river."
4.  Turn over and fold right and left points down to form a "roof."
5.  Like this. Then turn over the piece of paper.
6.  Bring the folded edges to meet the valley fold (the river). Crease flat.
7.  Unfold the top side points.
8.  Like this.
9.  Fold the top points down as shown.
10.  Fold the point upward to create a head.
11.  Lift the bottom edge to meet the vertical center line.
12.  Like this. Press flat and fold outward as shown.
13.  Repeat steps 11 and 12 with the other foot.
14.  Turn over. You've made a turtle!
